FIELD TRIPS FOR SUMMER 2026

DATES		WEEKLY DETAILS
1	06/29 - 07/03	Brave Explorers: Campers will explore Discovery Park and experience guided nature immersion through hands-on activities and observation. Campers will learn about local plants, wildlife, and environmental stewardship while hiking forest trails and coastal viewpoints. Campers will also visit Salmon Creek Ravine, where they will explore creek habitats, wooded ravines, and practice outdoor observation skills
2	07/06 - 07/10	Brave Explorers: Campers will explore Seward Park and experience old-growth forest trails along Lake Washington, learning about native trees, ecosystems, and outdoor safety. Campers will also visit Seahurst Ed Munro Park to explore beach habitats, tide pools, and forest paths while practicing teamwork, curiosity, and environmental awareness.
3	07/13 - 07/17	Inspired Artists: Campers will explore Kubota Garden, discovering plants, wildlife, and serene garden landscapes while using nature as inspiration for creative activities. Campers will also visit Camp Long, where they will engage in nature journaling, sketching, and sensory exploration in an old-growth forest environment.
4	07/20 - 07/24	Inspired Artists: Campers will visit the Duwamish Longhouse and Cultural Center to learn about local Indigenous history, culture, and the Duwamish River ecosystem. Campers will also explore the Environmental Science Center, participating in hands-on learning about marine life, coastal habitats, and environmental conservation.
5	07/27 - 07/31	Thrill Seekers: Campers will explore Lincoln Park, hiking forest trails and enjoying beach activities - building confidence and teamwork through outdoor challenges. Campers will rock climb at Momentum Climbing, focusing on problem-solving, strength, and supporting one another in a safe and exciting environment.
6	08/03-08/07	Thrill Seekers: Campers will visit Alki Beach to participate in outdoor games, beach exploration, and trail walks along the waterfront. Campers will also experience kayaking along local waterways, building outdoor skills, confidence, and teamwork while learning about water safety and marine environments.
7	08/10 - 08/14	Earth Lovers: Campers will explore Seahurst Ed Munro Park through beach ecology activities, learning about tide pools, coastal wildlife, and environmental stewardship. Campers will also visit Eagle Landing Park, where they will enjoy scenic viewpoints and learn about local waterways, habitats, and conservation efforts.
8	08/17-8/21	Earth Lovers: Campers will enjoy a Beach and Swim Day, spending time in the water while practicing water safety, cooperation, and outdoor fun. Campers will also participate in a reflection hike at Camp Long or Discovery Park, celebrating their growth, friendships, and connection to nature throughout the summer.
