FIELD TRIPS FOR SUMMER 2026

University of Washington, Seattle

DATES		WEEKLY DETAILS
1	[06/29 - 07/03]	Brave Explorers: Campers Explore Seward Park and experience guided nature immersion with Friends of North Creek. Through hands-on activities and observation, campers will learn about local plants, wildlife, and environmental stewardship.
2	[07/06 - 07/10]	Brave Explorers: Campers ages 5–8 will fish at Logboom Park, while ages 9–12 kayak at Bothell Landing, building outdoor skills and confidence. All campers will explore the wetlands at Magnuson Park, learning about local wildlife and ecosystems.
3	[07/13 - 07/17]	Inspired Artists: All campers will explore Kubota Gardens, discovering plants, wildlife, and serene garden landscapes. They will also visit the Duwamish Longhouse and Cultural Center to learn about local Indigenous history and culture.
4	[07/20 - 07/24]	Inspired Artists: All campers will explore the Arboretum, identifying trees and learning about local ecosystems. They will also visit the Burke Museum to discover natural history through engaging exhibits.
5	[07/27 - 07/31]	Thrill Seekers: Campers ages 5–8 will fish at Logboom Park while ages 9–12 kayak at Bothell Landing, building outdoor skills and confidence. All campers will participate in rock climbing, focusing on teamwork, problem-solving, and physical challenge.
6	[08/03 - 08/07]	Thrill Seekers: All campers will participate in a nature immersion with Friends of North Creek, exploring local habitats and wildlife. They will also discover trails and ecosystems at Discovery Park through hands-on exploration.
7	[08/10 - 08/14]	Earth Lovers: All campers will go rock climbing, building strength, confidence, and teamwork. They will also tour the Issaquah Salmon Hatchery with Friends of Issaquah to learn about salmon life cycles and conservation.
8	[08/17 - 08/21]	Earth Lovers: Campers ages 5–8 will hike from Bothell Landing to Blyth Park, while ages 9–12 will kayak at Bothell Landing, building outdoor skills and confidence. All campers will explore the Ballard Locks, learning about local waterways, wildlife, and engineering.
9	[08/24 - 08/28]	Thrill Seekers: All campers will go rock climbing, building strength, confidence, and teamwork. They will also hike, explore tidepools, and create beach art at Carkeek Park while learning about coastal ecosystems.
